The Companions

The most committed and dedicated MLC School and partnering boys' school senior students will be selected through a rigorous application process to be companions at this camp.

MLC School companions will be trained in the various aspects of their role and supported at all times by professional medical and teaching staff from the schools and parent volunteers.

Medical Support

Registered nurses will be on duty for the duration of the camp and doctors will be on-call 24 hours a day.
